2019 Te Wānanga o Raukawa Foundation Scholarships for the A.R.T Confederation and all other Iwi

The Te Wānanga o Raukawa Foundation scholarships are available to assist students studying with Te Wānanga o Raukawa in 2019. Students from any iwi may apply. A number of scholarships will be awarded to Ngā Uri o Te Kotahitanga o Te Āti Awa, Ngāti Raukawa, Ngāti Toa Rangatira (members of the ART Confederation).

All students are encouraged to apply.

Purpose

The purpose of the scholarship programme is to encourage and support students to undertake higher level¹ studies at Te Wānanga o Raukawa.

Eligibility

Open to students studying in a heke, poutuarongo, poutāhū or tāhuhu programme at Te Wānanga o Raukawa in 2019 except:

1. Teaching training students at Te Wānanga o Raukawa
2. Te Wānanga o Raukawa staff
3. Te Wānanga o Raukawa students who are eligible for TEC fees free funding in the study year²
4. Te Wānanga o Raukawa students who are in receipt of any other Te Wānanga o Raukawa scholarships including Educating the Whānau cohorts
5. Kura and college students

Priority will be given to those studying full time. However, applications from students studying more than a .5 load will also be considered. The value of the scholarship will reduce for students studying part time.

Application

Applicants are to complete the appropriate Te Wānanga o Raukawa Foundation Scholarship Application Form available on the website <https://www.wananga.com/scholarships.html>.

² If 'Fees Free' eligible this will be claimed for and if there are still fees to be paid the karahipi will be applied to the remainder of the fees

Applications open 1 December and close when all consumed. This is likely to be before 1 March 2019. Applications are considered monthly starting in January 2019.

Value

The value of the scholarship in 2019 is \$3,000 each. Scholarships open 1 December 2018 and close March 2019.

Payment

The scholarship is a contribution towards the fees for one year of study. Where fees have already been paid and there is no other debt to Te Wānanga o Raukawa there are two options:

1. the scholarship may be applied to the fees and any refund due will go to the payer; or
2. the scholarship may be paid directly to the recipient.

The scholarship is applied to fees and is paid in two instalments. The first portion is provided after confirmation of enrolment and after the 28 day withdrawal period. The balance is paid at the end of the academic year on confirmation of successful completion of the programme.

If the student is not progressing appropriately the second instalment will not be provided.

Conditions

The scholarship is conditional on fulfillment of all study requirements. Where requirements are not met the recipient may be required to repay the scholarship to Te Wānanga o Raukawa in 2019.

If reapplying, the academic record for previous years will be checked for completions. Preference will be given to those who are progressing. Non-completions in the prior year may result in the scholarship not being approved.

Scholarships may not be available to students who are likely to receive any other major scholarships (\$3,000 or more). Applicants are to declare if they have or may be applying for other scholarships.
